Subject: - Modification in Eligibility Criteria for Admission to ASU Courses and - information bulletin - ISM courses -NEET-UG 2025-reg.

Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject cited above, I am directed to inform you that, as per the discussions held during the Joint Commission Meeting on 21st January 2025, and in line with the recent amendment made by the National Commission for Homoeopathy (NCH), the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) has decided to adopt the following eligibility criteria for admission to undergraduate ASU&H courses:

“The candidate shall have passed 10+2 (or equivalent) with subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology or Biotechnology.”

2. With the approval of the Chairman, NCISM, it is further informed that all other provisions related to eligibility criteria as mentioned in the *NCISM (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2022* stand withdrawn.
3. The above decision shall be formally incorporated through an amendment to the respective regulations in due course.
4. In view of the above, you are requested to update the eligibility criteria for ASU courses accordingly in the Information Bulletin of NEET-UG 2025 under the section pertaining to Indian System of Medicine (ISM) courses.
