- (ii) Relevant requirements under the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) (Amendment) Regulations, 2012 read with amendment Regulations of 2013 (for UG Ayurveda).
- The college administration will ensure that sufficient qualified teachers and non-teaching staff in the college and requisite staff in the hospital, as per the relevant CCIM Regulations, are in position before the admission of the first batch of students in the 1st professional of BAMS course is made, under intimation to the Central Government and CCIM.
- The college has to develop the requisite infrastructure for IIrd, IIIrd and IVth professionals 3. well in time as per the CCIM norms which will be verified and reported by the CCIM at least three months before the start of next professional and accordingly, the permission for taking admissions in subsequent academic session will be issued.
- The college administration may take up the matter for recognition of the qualification 4. under section 14(2) of the IMCC Act, 1970 at that time when the first batch of students admitted against this course appears for the first final professional examination of the said course.
